Consideration has been given to the information and evidence available to us relating to our letter of charges dated October 20, 2021, and to your reply of October 29, 2021. Based on the information you supplied we will not be taking further action in the matter and consider this case closed.

Please be advised that the Food and Nutrition Service does monitor its authorized retailers for compliance with the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) and Pandemic EBT (P-EBT) regulations. You should take special care to prevent violations, such as, but not limited to, exchanging cash for EBT benefits, accepting EBT benefits from unauthorized individuals, the sale of ineligible items, the acceptance of EBT benefits on credit accounts, and the acceptance of EBT benefits for repayment of cash loans. You are responsible for any violations committed by employees working in the store.
